Introduction to the Book of Revelation

The writer: St John the Beloved while he was tortured and exiled at Batmos

Date : ~ 95 AD

The Place of writing: Patmos' Island

Major Theme: Final victory of the Jesus and His people over Satan and his powers, His second coming, the final judgement and the new heaven.

To whom it is written: to the persecuted church at the end of the first century and in all generations, to comfort her and declare her final victory and the glories waiting her at the end of days.

The nature of the book:

- 1) The only prophetic book in the NT (Apocalypses in Greek means revelation)
- 2) The revelation is recorded in a coded style (symbolic numerology), so many of its secrets are hidden, but declared only to the faithful in a spiritual way.
- 3) The interpretation of Revelation: There are mainly three approaches to interpret this difficult book:
 - 1: The contemporary approach: It assumes that the book is written for specific group of churches (1:11) with specific needs and at specific time
 - **2.** The future approach: It assumes that the book is addressing the last days only before the next coming, and all the events mentioned are actual events.
 - 3. The Ideal(spiritual) approach: It assumes that the book highlight the relationship and conflicts between God, His Kingdom and Satan. It reveals past, present and future events.

These three approaches may be used in conjunction.





Basic information about the first vision:

- 1. Jesus is "the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth".(1:5); He is coming with clouds,(1:7), "the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End" (1:8); like the Son of Man, clothed with a garment down to the feet and girded about the chest with a golden band.(1:13); His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire; His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, and His voice as the sound of many waters;(1:14-15); out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword, and His countenance was like the sun shining in its strength."(1:16); He is "in the midst of the seven lampstands" (1:13); He had in His right hand seven stars,(1:16)
- 2. The seven churches are existing churches in Asia Minor at that time, and also represent the status of the church at different ages till His next coming.
 - a. **Ephesus** represents "the Church in the Apostolic era"
 - b) **Smyrna** represents "the Church in the martyrdom during the Pagan Roman empire era"
 - c) **Pergamos** represents "the Church associated with the civil authority in the era of Christian Roman Empire"
 - d) **Thyatira** represents "the Church in the middle ages when it is full of earthly treasures and fainted spirit.
 - e) **Sardis** represents "the church in about the 16th. century when the Catholic church sell the forgiveness document, and the revolution of Martin Luther"
 - f) **Philadelphia** represents "the church in our time now where the different churches try to come near together and unified".
 - g) **Laodicea.** Represents "the church of the last days when it became lukewarm and apostate"

The Lampstands are the churches and the stars are the angels of the churches who are the pastoral leadership of the local churches (the Bishops)

- **3.** For each church there are:
 - a) Short introduction of Christ with descriptive title
 - b) Summary of the state of the church, with praise or rebuke.
 - c) Exhortation is given
 - d) The message concluded by: "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches." and a promise
- **4.** The advice for four of the seven churches of the Lord is "Repent"
- **5.** . **Nicolaitans**: are the followers of one of the seven deacons "Nicolas" who spread a heresy encouraging living in lust without control, and allowing adultery and eating idol's offerings.
- **6.** "doctrine of Balaam" is the devilish advice given by the "Balaam the false prophet" to "Balaak" [refer to Num.22-25]. The advise is to teach the people to " eat things sacrificed to idols, and to commit sexual immorality"


