1. General Aims of the unit.

To have an insight in the life of Saints to imitate their path, have the courage to witness Christ and imitate their virtues.

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. 1. To overview the time of St. Rewis (departed 18/10/1404), the Pope at that time and the Egyptian ruler
