A Call To Preach The Good News Code: 12/FE/6

1. General Aims of the unit

To live and celebrate The feast of the Apostles and share in their zeal to spread the name of Jesus Christ

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. Cover briefly the call of some preachers like the call of Peter , Andrew , James and John (Matt. 4:18-22) ; Matthew(Matt. 9:9-13) ,and St. Paul (Acts 9:1-20). And also some of the people whom the Lord heals them from their illnesses like the Demoniac person (Luke 8:26-39)
- 2. Cover also some of the calls which were rejected like those who found excuses not to accept the call (Luke 9:59-62) or the young man who came to Him (Mark 10:17-22)
- 3. Highlight the benefits which the person gain when he/she accept the call (Matt. 19:27-29)
- 4. Concentrate on the commission of the Lord to all His disciples to preach the good news (Matt. 8:19-20). And how the Christians of the Apostolic era practice this (Acts 8:4; 11:19-21)

3. Outcomes:

By the end of this lessons the teens are able to:

- 1. Express his/her role in building the kingdom of heaven by preaching the good news.
- 2. Analyse why some rejected the call of Jesus to work with Him and spread the good news.
- 3. Record his/her personal specific call (which suits the personal abilities and talents) and his / her response.
- 4. Pray daily that the Lord may support Him/her to accept His call.
- 5. Remember by heart the great gifts he/she received when they accept His call.
