
- What is a commandment?
 - An authoritative direction or instruction to do something



The Ten Commandments

what are they?

1. I am the Lord Your God You shall have no other gods before Me
2. You shall not make for yourself a carved image
3. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain
4. Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
5. Honour your father and your mother
6. You shall not murder.
7. You shall not commit adultery.
8. You shall not steal.
9. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbour.
10. You shall not covet* anything that is your neighbour's.




* **Covet**: Wish, long, or crave for (something, especially the property of another person)

The Ten Commandments

are they important?

- Where are they in the Holy Bible?
 - Exodus 20
- They were spoken by...
 - GOD!
- Written by...
 - GOD!
- Written on...
 - 2 Tablets of Stone
- How many times did God write them?
 - Twice! - the first time on the 2 stone tablets that Moses broke and the second time on 2 tablets like the former ones (Deut 10:41 & Ex 34:1)
- Why 10?
 - The number 10 is a symbol of perfection.
 - The Parable of the Ten Virgins (Matt. 25:1) – 10 refers to the whole world
 - The Parable of the Lost Coin (Luke 15:8) – the 10 coins symbolise all that she had



the Greatest Commandment...

- What did Jesus say when he was asked what was the greatest of all the Commandments?
 - “Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?” Jesus said to him, “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.’ This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.” (Matt 22:36-40)
- Jesus' answer summarised the 2 tablets precisely:

TABLET 1

“You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.”

The Commandments are all about ... ?




Love!
