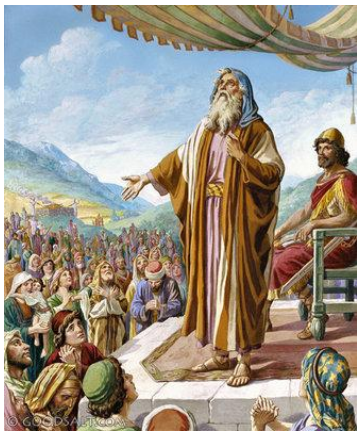
Monday (Read 1 Samuel 12:1-7)

(1) What request did the Israelites make of Samuel which he fulfilled for them? (hint- verse 1)

(2) Samuel recognises that his time on earth was drawing to an end and is making a farewell speech to the Israelites. When he asks them to witness against him, how do the Israelites respond (Hint-verse 4)

(3) Which two bible characters does Samuel refer to in his speech to the Israelites when he mentions the fathers who the Lord brought from the land of Egypt?

(4) What is the main purpose of Samuel's speech to the Israelites? (hint- verse 7)



Tuesday (Read 1 Samuel 12:8-15)

(5) When the Israelites had in the past sinned by worshipping Idols, what did God do for them when they repented? (Hint- verse 11)

(6) Even though the Israelites had demanded a King, they already had one, even though they didn't know it. Who was this King? (Hint- verse 12)

(7) What clear warnings does Samuel give the Israelites in verse 14 and 15?

Wednesday (Read 1 Samuel 12:16-25)

(8) In order to show the Israelites the extent of their wickedness by asking for a King, what did Samuel do?

(9) Even when we sin, should we turn aside from God? What should we do instead? (hint- verse 20)

(10) What promise is made to all the people of the Lord, in verse 22?

(11) How should we always serve the Lord? (Hint- verse 24)

(12) How long has Saul reigned Israel?

(13) How many men did Saul pick to attack the Philistines?

(14) What did Saul do to draw attention to himself following his attack? (Hint- verse 3)

(15) What did the Philistines gather together in order to fight back against the Israelites?

(16) When the men of Israel saw that they were in danger, they became fearful. Where did they hide?

(17) Did Samuel return to Gilgal after 7 days?



Friday (Read 1 Samuel 13:9-15)

(18) What big mistake does Saul commit?

(19) Had Saul obeyed the commandments of God, what would have happened to his kingdom? (Hint- verse 13)

(20) What kind of King had the Lord wanted to reign over his people? (Hint- verse 14)

(21) When Samuel left Gilgal, where did he go?

(22) How many people remained with Saul?
