(1) What instruction was given to David by the Lord in verse 2?

(2) When David followed the instructions of the Lord despite being worried for his own life, what did the Lord do for him?

(3) In verses 10-12, during his time of uncertainty, what did David do?

(4) Because David listened to the Lord, what happened and what did Saul do? (Hint- verse 13)

(5) Based on today's reading, what lessons can we learn from the example that David set for us?

Tuesday (Read 1 Samuel 23:14-29)

(6) According to verse 14, how is David rewarded for his loyalty to God?

(7) As a dear and loyal friend to David, what does the bible say Jonathon did for David's relationship with God? (Hint- verses 16, 18)

(8) Although Saul repeatedly tried to capture David, he was unsuccessful in doing so, for the Lord was with David and the Lord protected David from Saul. How can you apply the lessons from today's reading in your own life?

(9) Why was the name of the place in which David was hiding changed so that it was called "the Rock of Escape"

Wednesday (Read 1 Samuel 22: 1-22)

(10) What reason does David give for not killing Saul when it would have been so easy for him? (Hint- how does David refer to Saul in verse 6)

(11) What does David's cutting of Saul's robe represent? (Hint- verse 11)

(12) Who is in charge of vengeance? (Hint- verse 12)

(13) What request does Saul make of David which David grants him? (Hint- verses 21-22)



Thursday (Read 1 Samuel 25:1-17)

(14) When Samuel died, where was he buried?

(15) In verses 2-3, what do we learn about the type of person Nabal was?

(16) When David hears that Nabal is shearing his sheep in the wilderness what does he ask 10 of his men to do?

(17) In verses 10-11, how does Nabal respond to David's request?

(18) When David hears of Nabal's response how many men does he ask to gird on their swords and follow him?

(19) Summarise what Abigail is told about the incident, by one of Nabal's young men

Friday (Read 1 Samuel 25:18-31)

(20) In response to what Abigail is told, what does she arrange for David and his men?

(21) What did David plot to do to Nabal and his people because of the way Nabal treated him? (Hint- verses 21-22)

(22) Briefly summarise what Abigail does and says to David, in verses 23-31, upon meeting him



Saturday (Read 1 Samuel 25:32-44)

(23) Why do you think David accepted Abigail's offerings and prevented the bloodshed of Nabal and his people?

(24) Why Did Abigail wait till morning before mentioning anything to Nabal?

(25) What happened to Nabal after hearing what Abigail had to say?

(26) What happened to Abigail following the death of Nabal?
