# The Feast of Transfiguration Code: 11/FE/7

[Matt.17:1-9, Mark 9:2-10, Luke 9:28-36, John 1:14]

### 1. General Aims of the unit

To celebrate the feasts of the church with more understanding of the occasion and its significance in our spiritual life

## 2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. To highlight the seven major and the seven minor Lordly feasts
- 2. To explore the event of the Transfiguration from the 3 synoptic gospels.
- 3. To relate the Transfiguration on the mountain with the resurrection of the Lord.
- 4. To identify the witnesses of the Transfiguration (either from the OT or from the NT)and the significance of their presence.

#### 3. Outcomes:

## By the end of this lessons the teens are able to:

- 1. Recite the major and minor Lordly feasts in our church
- 2. Analyse the characteristics of each of the personalities appeared on the mountain with the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 3. Reason why Moses and Elijah were taking to Jesus about His decease which He was about to accomplish in Jerusalem
- 4. Discover the mistakes St. Peter did when he asked for tabernacles to cover Jesus, Moses and Elijah.
- 5. Identify the occasions when the glory of our Lord appeared and the voice of the Father heard.
