Drugs and Alcohols(3) Code: 11/SO/6

1. General Aims of the unit

To update the teens about the effect of addiction on teens to avoid it.

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. To review with the teens the scientific meaning of addiction, substance causing addiction (smoking, alcohol, different types of drugs,...) [more advanced knowledge is needed as the teens knew in previous years some information about this topic]
- 2. To explore the psychological needs and motives that lead to addiction.
- 3. To explore the different types of drugs in the market , their damaging effect , both physically and spiritually .
- 4. To learn how to avoid falling in addiction.

3. Outcomes:

By the end of this lessons the teens are able to:

- 1. Discuss and debate the harmful effect of addiction and the damaging effect of the different families of drugs and alcohols.
- 2. Share in a debate about the situations that they face in the schools and/or society that lead them to addiction and how to avoid them.
- 3. Practice the way for victory through the strong relation with Jesus Christ and the church and be an advocate for their peers.
