A simplified Liturgical cycle of the church Code: 12/CH/1

1. General Aims of the unit

To live and practice the spiritual life through our church traditions and rites.

- 2. Interrelate between the Liturgical cycles of the church and their spiritual daily life.
- 3. Record some elements from each cycle to practice and feel the blessings of the presence of Jesus Christ in their lives.
