1. General Aims of the unit

To live and celebrate One of the major feasts of the Lord 'the day of Pentecost' and know more about His gifts to the believers to acquire them.

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. Cover briefly the events of the day of Pentecost [explore in details if they are not clearly remembered and understood)
- 2. Highlight the relation between the acceptance of the Holy Spirit in our baptism and the fullness of the Holy Spirit in our daily life. And the means that lead to fullness of the Spirit
- 3. Differentiate between the fruits and the gifts of the Spirit.
- 4. Name and understand the different gifts of the Spirit in the church and the biblical conditions for their authenticity.

3. Outcomes:

- 1. Remember by heart how the Holy Spirit descend on the church on the day of Pentecost, and how He descend on us now.
- 2. Differentiate between the descend and the fullness of the Spirit by practical examples.
- 3. Discuss and apply the requirements needed to be given one or more of these gifts
- 4. Set a table of the gifts of the Spirit and the benefits of the church from each one of them
