**What we learn from 1 Kings 21: 17-29**

***The Nature Of Repentance***

Ahab is a marvel. Just when you think him beyond all hope, he repents. We can learn from his repentance:

- Repentance is rooted in humility – Ahab humbled himself before the Lord. It makes sense - for humility comes from comparing ourselves with Almighty God.
- Repentance although difficult at first, is worth the trouble. It cannot restore Naboth; it cannot undo the past – but it can remove the barrier of sin between us and God.

***Gods Reprieve***

God spares Ahab, from the calamities that he deserved... But Consider: if God can forgive Ahab, who was an evil king and ruler – don't you think He can forgive you?
