

What we learn from 1 Kings 21: 17-29 The Nature Of Repentance

Ahab is a marvel. Just when you think him beyond all hope, he repents. We can learn from his repentance:

•<u>Repentance is rooted in humility</u> – Ahab humbled himself before the Lord. It makes sense - for humility comes from comparing ourselves with Almighty God.

• <u>Repentance although difficult at first, is worth the trouble</u>. It cannot restore Naboth; it cannot undo the past – but it can remove the barrier of sin between us and God.

Gods Reprieve

God spares Ahab, from the calamities that he deserved... <u>But Consider</u>: if God can forgive Ahab, who was an evil king and ruler – <u>don't you think He</u> <u>can forgive you?</u>
