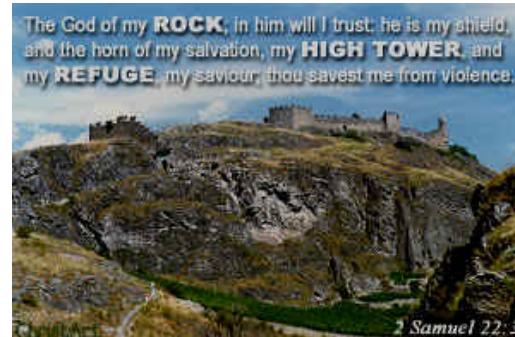

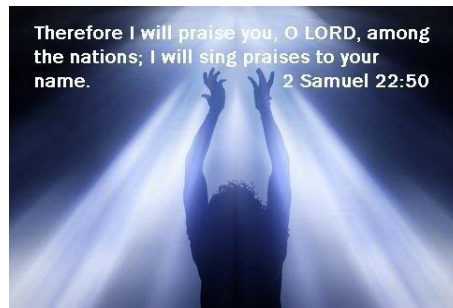

Did You Know? (2 Samuel 22)

Did you know that 2 Samuel 22 is identical to psalm 18 in many parts. It is a summary of the life of David and the important role that God played in his life. Within Chapter 22 we see 6 important themes emerge:

- 1) God is a rock for David
- 2) David asks God for help
- 3) God answers David
- 4) Why God gives help to His people
- 5) Everything that David owns comes from God
- 6) God made David King

These themes & the verses behind them should serve as a huge comfort in our own lives. We should use them to reflect on what having a relationship with God can and should mean to us!!!
