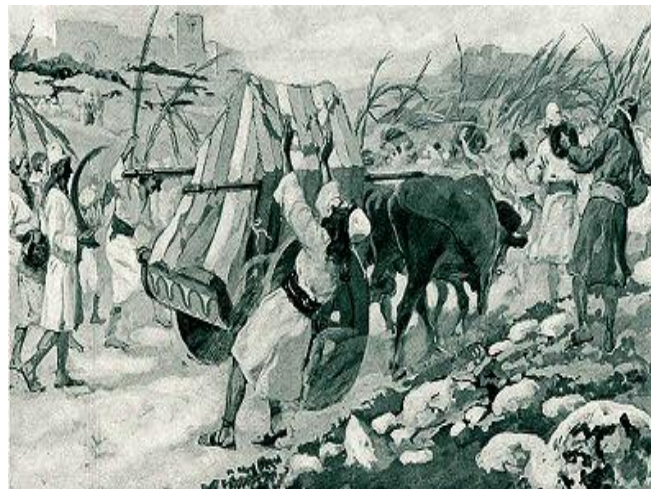

Did you Know?

The ancient Israelites preferred stringed instruments for their worship services and percussion instruments for their parties and celebrations. The instruments the Israelites played were probably quite different from our instruments today. For example, the sistrums mentioned in Ch 6 verse 5 were probably U-shaped frames with small metal pieces or other objects strung between the parts of the U. Held by handles at the bottom, the sistrums were used to create a rattling sound.
