GETTING THEIR ATTENTION - CHILDREN COLLAGE

Materials needed:

Magazines

Scissors

Glue sticks

Poster board

WHAT THE SERVANT DOES: (To prepare ahead)

Draw a large circle on the poster board. Have it take up the majority of the poster board.

Put in the middle of the circle The Picture in page 3

WHAT THE CHILDREN DO:

Give each child a magazine. Have them look for pictures of children, cut them out, and glue them inside the circle on the poster board. When the circle is full of children explain to your students that the Bible story today is about children; all kinds of children. They didn't look like these children; they didn't dress like these children, but Jesus drew them into His circle of love because He loves children!

Lesson Outline:

- Jesus was teaching people about God and how He wants them to live.
- As He used to do everyday, He was telling them very nice stories. He also healed the people who were sick.
- One day, some parents came to Jesus with their kids to bless them, The children were very excited!! They longed to meet the wonderful Teacher they heard of.
- However, the disciples (Jesus helpers) told the parents of the children: Oh no don't annoy Jesus as the kids are very loud and making noises... let them go and play away from here.
- When Jesus heard the disciples, he was not happy at all about what they said. **He turned to the children and He took them in His arms drawing them close to Him and He blessed them by laying His hands on their heads.**
- He told His disciples, Let the little children come to Me and don't forbid them. Jesus also told them that **God would only allow us to the kingdom of heaven if we are as pure and nice as little children.**
- Jesus told everyone how we all should love one another and how we should love little children, Jesus told people that children are very important to Him and we all should love and respect them.

Conclusion

Jesus Loves children and He told everyone how much we should love and respect little kids.

Jesus made it clear that **God would only allow us to the kingdom of heaven if we are as pure and nice as little children.**

Application

- Do we also love Jesus? How can we show Jesus that we love Him?
- By loving one another, also if we have younger brothers or sisters at home, we should love them and be kind with them.
- Praying for our friends and others also show love and care.
