1. General Aims of the unit

Emphasize the Divinity of Christ through His authority which appeared in His miracles

2. Special aims of the lesson

1) Study in details the miracles that shows the power of Jesus Christ over nature and proof that He is God incarnate. The miracles studied may be some or all of the following

a) Converting the water into wine b) Feeding the 5,000 John 6 :4-14 C) Walking over the water John 6:16-21

d) Authorizing St. Peter to walk over the water Matt. 14:22-33
e) Calming the storm Matt. 8:23-27, Mark 4:35-41

f) Catching great number of fish Luke 5:1-10

g) Darkness in the time of His crucifixion Matt. 27:45; Luke 23:44-45
 h) Catching 153 big fishes after Resurrection John 21:3-11

- 2) In each of the miracles, show how Jesus Christ the Creator is able to proof His authority by changing the rules when there is an actual need for His people.
- 3) Show in each miracle how the disciples and the followers believe that He is the Messiah the Son of God

3.Outcomes

By the end of this lesson the teens are able to:

- 1) Show with evidence the aim of all the miracles Jesus did.
- 2) Convince others (non believers) through a debate (using only the miracles that show Jesus authority over nature) that Jesus is the Son of God, because no one else did these miracles with His own authority except Jesus
