1. General Aims of the unit

Emphasize the Divinity of Christ through His authority which appeared in His miracles

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1) Study in details the 3 miracles of death; raising of the daughter of Jairus (Mrk5:21-43), the son of the widow of Nain (Luke 7:11-17) and Lazarus (John 11:1-52). Explain the meaning of the length of time each one of the resurrected people spent dying.
- 2) Identify the meaning of "death", relate it to Adam's sin and judgment. Show the role of Jesus Christ to take off the penalty of death and grants us resurrection.
- 3) Relate these miracles with the resurrection of Christ and the resurrection of the bodies in the next coming of Christ .
- 4) In each miracle show that one of the main reason for performing the miracle is the Lord's sharing with the sad people.
- 5) Concentrate on showing the Divinity of Christ who has the power to order the return the life to the dead

3. Outcomes

By the end of this lesson the teens are able to:

- 1) Prove the Divinity of Christ the creator and giver of life.
- 2) Debate the reword of sins in our lives, and the authority of Jesus Christ to wave out our death penalty and when we receive this pardon.
- 3) Summarize the feelings that led our Lord Jesus Christ to interfere and perform these great miracles
