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1. General Aims of the unit

- 2. List all types of punishments that the Christians suffered during the early life of the church.
- 3. Describe the main job of the Deacon at that time? , the prerequisites of this rank (refer to 1 Tim.3:8-10) the job of the deacons now and their different categories.
- 4. Analyze the speech in Ch.7, pick up the main ideas that defend the Lord Jesus Christ, and the main outcomes of the speech.
