#### 1. General Aims of the unit

## 2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. Understand the creation of Adam and Eve as mentioned in Gen. 1:27-30, 2:7,15-25, their sin and the its reword Gen.3
- 2. Prove in a simple way that the human race is created and not through evolution
- 3. Analyze the main sin of Adam and Eve ( disobedience- not accepting responsibility of sinful deed) and the promise of God for salvation
- 4. Compare between Adam and Jesus who came to free Adam and his descendant from death and overcome the main sin of Adam and Eve.

- 1. Compare between the first Adam and Jesus the second Adam in birth, in style of life, in obedience, in carrying the burden of sin and in victory
