1. General Aims of the unit

To have an insight in the life of Saints to imitate them as they imitate Christ and followed Him

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. To study the life of Pope Kyrellos VI since his early life
- 2. Highlight his eagerness to the life of prayer and his struggle to practiced it.
- 3. Explore the power of prayer in his personal life and in performing miracles to those who are in need to them.

Outcomes:

By the end of this lesson the teens are able to:

- 1. Tell the story of Pope Kyrellos, and concentrate on the pivotal events in his life as heading to solitude outside the monastry, leaving the Baramos monastery,
- 2. Debate his reasons for choosing life of prayer and examples of his insistence to practice it
- 3. Show the items of his life of continuous prayer (Psalms, Tasbeha, Raising incense and daily Liturgies)
- 4. Mention occasions where the power of prayer is evident.
- **5.** Remember by heart at least one of his quotations about prayer, as (Is. 62:6-7) " ... You who make mention of the Lord, do not keep silent, And give Him no rest till He establishes And till He makes Jerusalem a praise in the earth."
- 6. Ask the intercession of Pope Kyrellos to be inspired to imitate his life of prayer
