
Summary of the life of Saint Paul

He was born to a Jewish family in Tarsus of Cilicia.

- He was given the name of Saul (Hebrew) and Paul (Roman)
- He was from the tribe of Benjamin , circumcised on the 8th. day according to the Law of Moses , a Hebrew , and Pharisee (Phil. 3:5)

 According to the Jewish traditions each one have to have a trade. The trade of Saul was tent making (Acts 18:3)



- He was very zealous to the religion of his fathers and the traditions of his nation (Gal. 1:13-14), so he proudly guarded the clothes of the fanatics who stoned St. Stephen.(Acts 7:58).
- But beyond any doubt the last words of St. Stephen touched deeply in his heart and prepared him to accept the message of Jesus when he appeared to him.

 He took orders from the High Priest to kill and torture the believers in Damascus. On his way the Lord of Glory appeared to him and touched his heart . He was converted and received his sight when St. Ananias put his hand on him. He was baptized and filled with the Holy Spirit.(Acts 9: 1-22)
