- 1. Explain the details of the miracle stressing the these points:
 - ❖ Why the disciples asked the Lord about the cause of blindness?
 - The mission of Jesus Christ.
 - ❖ Why Jesus used *clay* to open the blind eyes.
 - ❖ The denial of the parents to witness the miracle.
 - ❖ Why the *Pharisees* were not accepting the miracle.
 - ❖ The progress of the level of faith of the blind man in Jesus Christ
 - ❖ The great evidence of the miracle is 'the open eyes of the blind'
 - ❖ Why the Lord Jesus did this miracle (sign) [A sign is a miracle coupled with the suitable teaching)
- 2. Understand the spiritual meaning of 'blindness' and the relation between baptism and opening the eyes of the blind and why we call this Sunday "Sunday of Baptism"
- 3. The relation between believe in Jesus Christ and worshipping Him

3.Outcomes

By the end of this lesson the teens are able to:

- 1. Recite the relation between 'receiving sight' and 'baptism'
- 2. Show the uniqueness of this miracle as it needs creation through dust and compare it to the creation of Adam (Gen. 2:7)

- 4. Compare themselves with this blind man in witnessing Jesus Christ in their actual lives.
