1. General Aims of the unit

- 2. The love and care of our Lord Jesus Christ to this sinful woman and the way He attracted her to repentance.
- 3. The saltiness of the water of the world. The fullness is only through the live water which we get it through Jesus Christ (the Holy Spirit)
- 4. The food of Jesus is the return of everyone to the kingdom of heaven (the white fields).
- 5. Preaching the good news to others is the true sign of our repentance and return to the Lord...

3.Outcomes

By the end of this lesson the teens are able to:

- 1. Express the differences between the Jews and Samaritans
- 2. Differentiate between the salty water of the world and the live water of Christ in practical terms from their lives
- 3. Recall from his/her own experience how the beloved Lord deals with them to encourage them to repentance
