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(Ex. 3-11) *"Introduction to the books of Exodus , Numbers and Deuteronomy"*

1. General Aims of the unit

Better Understanding of the Pentateuch (the 5 books of Moses) and the dealings of God with them during their journey to the promised land

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. To highlight the outcomes of the meetings between Moses and the Lord God, Moses and his brother Aaron, Moses and Pharaoh.
- 2. To explore the characteristics of the personality of Moses after 40 years in the wilderness , and that of Pharaoh
- 3. To detail the 10 plagues the Lord God sent to Egypt(leave the last one to next week)
- 4. To highlight the power, miracles given to Moses to face Pharaoh and lead the Israelites out of Egypt

3.Outcomes

By the end of this lesson the teens are able to:

- 1. Explain the meaning of "the Lord harden the heart of Pharaoh".
- 2. Remember by heart the 10 plagues
- 3. Compare between the power of the rod of Aaron and the sticks of the sorcerers.
- 4. Reason why Moses refused first the mission to go to Egypt.
