1. General Aims of the unit

Better Understanding of the Pentateuch (the 5 books of Moses) and the dealings of God with His people during their journey to the promised land

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. To detail all the events happening on the 10th. and the 14th. of Abib; and the 7 days after the 14th.day.
- 2. To explore the value of the blood on the doorposts and the lintel of the house to protect the first born child inside.
- 3. To understand the reason of taking off the leaven bread from the houses of Israelites for 7 days
- 4. To understand that Jesus Christ is our Passover.

3.Outcomes

By the end of this lesson the teens are able to:

- 1. Write in a point form the preparation of the lamb of Passover, the preparation of Jews and the features of the houses of the Israelites .
