1. General Aims of the unit

Better Understanding of the Pentateuch (the 5 books of Moses) and the dealings of God with His people during their journey to the promised land

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. To detail all the events of crossing the Red sea
- 2. To relate the crossing of the sea with baptism in the water as St. Paul in the epistle of Corinthians mentioned. (1Cor. 10:1-2)
- 3. To explore the feeling before and after crossing the sea and relate it with the feelings of Joy after baptism
- 4. To understand the praise of the 1st. hose (Ex. 15, Rev. 15:2-4)

3.Outcomes

By the end of this lesson the teens are able to:

- 1. Debate the value of faith in crossing the red sea and in baptism (Heb.11:28-29).
- 2. Draw similarity between Pharaoh and the devil in preventing God's people from leaving slavery . Compare this to the role of devil now against the children of God.
- 3. Recite part of the 1st. hose in the class
