3. Washing / Remission of sins

4. Burial and resurrection with Christ

* "Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were <u>baptized into His death</u>? Therefore we were <u>buried with Him through baptism into</u> <u>death</u>..... For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be in the <u>likeness of His resurrection</u>" Romans 6: 3 - 5

"... <u>buried with Him in baptism</u>, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God" Colossians 2:12



5. Putting on Christ

"For as many of you as\were baptized into Christ have put on

Christ" Galatians 3:27

"... buried with Him in baptism" Colossians 2:12



Baptism of the Children

- *Circumcision in the 8th day.*
 - Crossing of the Red Sea.
- Saving of the children of Israel through the blood of the lamb of the Passover
- Baptism of the multitude in the day of Pentecost and other families e.g. Philippians' jailer, Lydia the seller of Purple.

Their Baptism Was Not A Guarantee of Perseverance


