1. General Aims of the unit

Better Understanding of the Pentateuch (the 5 books of Moses) , specially the events occurred during the journey in the wilderness till reaching the promised land

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. Brief the journey of the Israelites till they camped in the plains of Moab
- 2. Highlight the person "Balaam" was he a true prophet or witchcraft /fortune teller?
- 3. Detail how God prevent Balaam from cursing the people of God
- 4. Highlight his devilish advice and how it caused the wrath of God and killing of 24,000 Israelites
- 5. Highlight how God used this false prophet (or witchcraft) to prophesies about the birth of Christ

- 1. Debate the life of Balaam and his major sins as described by St. Peter and St. Jude in their epistles.
- 2. Trace the devilish advice of Balaam to Balak, its results. Does the devil still using this advice up till now?(refer also to the church of Thyatira)
- 3. Write a recipe for our mates to overcome the contemporary sins of the world which are reflection to the advice of Balaam.
