Lesson: St Bakhomious and the Strangers

Aim of the lesson: To look at some of the things in our lives we have to sacrifice, if we are serious about wanting to follow Jesus, just as Saint Bakhomious did.

Bible References: None given.

Activity:

- There are three containers, each labeled with either; wisdom, possessions or humility.
- As a class, the servant is to hold up a picture/scenario and discuss with the class which container it should go into.
- The children then choose whether we have to give up that behavior to live as Christ would want us to; then choose which container it would go in, because the behaviors are opposite of the quality on the container.
- Not all of the examples will go in the containers, but the children have to decide.


WISDOM:

Not turning up to soccer training because it is too cold, or you want to play on play station.




WISDOM:
