Jesus is the source of blessing

Memory Verse: "And when He had taken the f____ loaves and the t___ fish, He looked up to heaven, blessed and broke the loaves, and gave them to His disciples to set before them; and the two fish He divided among them a____." (Mark 6:41)

Verse 13 reminds us of the church sacrament of "the unction of the sick". TRUE or FALSE


The royal King Herod was afraid of John The Baptist, the holy man of God. (verse 20) TRUE or FALSE

CIRCLE THE CORRECT WORD: (Mark 6:30-52)

Jesus told His disciples to give the multitude something to (eat, do). They had (Five loaves/2fish, 6loaves/2fish). Jesus commanded that (first in/first served, everyone to sit down in groups). He looked up to heaven (blessed, covered), and broke the loaves and divided the 2 fish. The remaining crumbs and pieces filled (12, 1) basket(s) after feeding (50, 5000) men, other than the women and children.
