## The Gospel of St Mark

### Chapter 7

**MEMORY VERSE:** And they were astonished beyond measure, saying, "He has done a few things well. He makes both the deaf to hear and the mute to speak." Mark 7: 37 **Bonus 5 points if you memorise this verse**

### Please Read Mark 7:1-23



Discuss this passage with one of your parents or grandparents. Jesus tried to show the people the difference between the Pharisees (whom he called hypocrites) and those with a true faith. He talks about 2 points: The first one is in verse 10-12. These are people who refuse to help their parents and honour them, pretending to give gifts to God instead. Really, what they are doing is using these gifts themselves and not giving them to their parents or to God.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> point is a bit easier to understand: verse 18-20. Can you tell me what it is?

### CIRCLE THE CORRECT WORD: (Mark 7: 24-30)

A woman whose young (son, daughter) had an unclean spirit heard about Him, and she came and (asked Him, fell at His feet).
