Chapter 15

In this chapter, we continue the story of Samson. We see two amazing things in this chapter – Samson able to defeat an army of 1000 Philistines on his own, and God giving water to drink out of the ground. And did you know what the purposes of reading about These events are? Well there are many, but the main one is so that we see how God deals with others, and realise that He deals this Way with us too! So if you are loyal to God as Samson was (initially) then He can do amazing things in your life too!

Monday: Judges 15: 1-10

- 2. What did the Philistines do to Samson's wife and her father?



Tuesday: Judges 15:11-20

- 1. How many men of Judah went to speak to Samson?
- 2. What did they say to him? (Hint v12)

Basically what has happened so far in this chapter is that Samson wanted to see his wife. Unfortunately, her father have her to another man. Samson was very angry that he could not see his wife, and so in his anger, burnt the fields of the Philistines with 300 foxes with torches tied to their tails. In response to this, the Philistines started to attack the people of the tribe of Judah. The people of Judah then told the Philistines that they weren't responsible for the destroyed fields – it was Samson. Then they delivered Samson to them...

1. Who was Delilah?

2. What did the Philistines ask her to do? (hint: v5-6)

3. How many times did Samson trick Delilah and lie about the wway to make him weak, like any other man? (Hint: v15)

Thursday: Judges 16:16-22

- 1. We see hear Samson breaking His promise to God. He promised God that no razor would ever touch his head (i.e. he would never get his hair cut. But he broke that promise and his strength left him. This teaches us that if we break our promises to God, there can be same nasty consequences. On the other hand, if we keep the promises we make to God, we get great blessings. Can you think of an example of someone in the Bible who was loyal to God and got great blessings?
- 2. What did the Philistines do to Samson when they caught him? (Hint: v21)
