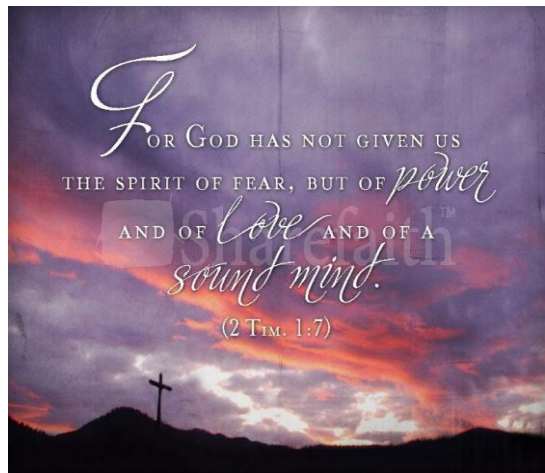

The bible is the source of Truth worthy of our trust ■ Paul urges Timothy to tell people the good news and to be a real servant to God.
