1. General Aims of the unit

Better Understanding of the "Old Testament" and detailed study the life of great prophets

2. Special aims of the lesson

I. Revision in brief about the kingdom of Israel , why king Jeroboam the son of Nebat cause Israel to drift away from worshipping God, and what is the role of the prophet in this case.

2.Study the life of the Prophet in details,

 - The blessing of the "bin of flour and the jar of oil" of the widow of Zarephath (1Kin.17:8-16)
 - Raising up the son of the widow (1Kin. 1717-24)
 - Consuming 50 soldiers and their leader 2 times (2Kin. 1:9-14)
