Elisha was Elijah's Disciple

Elijah found Elisha working in his father's fieldElijah cast his mantle (cloak) on him

- Cost Elisha immediately left what he was doing, and followed "the man of God"
- Similar to the disciples, when Jesus called them to follow Him, they left what they were doing and immediately followed him..

He served Elijah while he was aliveHe learnt from Elijah how to be a man of God

Discipleship

- Re was loyal to Elijah, and wanted to stay near him all the time so he can gain from him.
 - CM Then Elijah said to Elisha, "Stay here, please, for the Lord has sent me on to Bethel." But Elisha said, "As the Lord lives, and as your soul lives, I will not leave you!" So they went down to Bethel. (2 Kings 2:2)

Elijah was very strict when it came to dealing with sin

- Real Naaman pleaded with Elisha to give him a gift, but Elisha refused
- Rever, Elisha's disciple Gehazi was very greedy:
 - "Look, my master has spared Naaman this Syrian, while not receiving from his hands what he brought; but as the Lord lives, I will run after him and take something from him." (2 Kings 5:20)

Elijah was very strict when it came to dealing with sin

He ran after Naaman, and asked him for a talent of silver which would help his master Elisha ...Naaman was very generous, and so gave him 2 talents
We're not sure exactly how much that's worth today
Estimates are that each talent is worth around \$25,000
He returned to Elisha, and Elisha asked him where did you go? He lied to Elisha, but Elisha knew very well he went to Naaman

Recursed him with Leprosy, him and his descendants forever

Youth that mocked Elisha

"Then he went up from there to Bethel; and as he was going up the road, some youths came from the city and mocked him, and said to him, "Go up, you baldhead! Go up, you baldhead!" So he turned around and looked at them, and pronounced a curse on them in the name of the Lord. And two female bears came out of the woods and mauled forty-two of the youths." 2 Kings 2:23-24

Moses Story

- Miriam and Aaron spoke against Moses after he had married an ethiopian woman (mixed marriages were wrong at the time)
- Moses was humble, and didn't defend himself...God defended him.
 - "Hear now My words. If there is a prophet among you, I, the Lord, make Myself known to him in a vision; I speak to him in a dream. 7 Not so with My servant Moses; He is faithful in all My house. 8 I speak with him face to face, Even plainly, and not in dark sayings; And he sees the form of the Lord. *Why then were you not afraid To speak against My servant Moses*? Numbers 12
- Moses prayed to the Lord to heal her.

- Show respect to God, through respecting what is his: Prayer, The Bible, and the Elders of the Church, including the elders of the Church at your home (your parents).
