1. General Aims of the unit

Better Understanding of the gospels which are the record of the life of Jesus Christ

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. to have adequate knowledge about the writer of the gospel, the main theme of the gospel, to whom the gospel was written, the proposed time of writing, the symbol of this gospel and an idea about the synoptic gospels
- 2. to explore the characteristics of the gospel and its main parts.
- 3. to remember some events mentioned only in this gospel

3.Outcomes

By the end of this lesson the teens are able to:

- 1. give a full account about the gospel according to St. Luke; the writer , the timing , the target group ,its symbol and the main message of this gospel
- 2. Discuss the characteristics of the gospel and how it is related to its theme and the targeted people.
- 3. Remember the main events and parts that is mentioned only in St. Luke gospel.

APPENDIX

The fathers of the Church represents the four gospels by the faces of the four living creatures in the midst of the throne "……. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back. The first living creature was like a lion, the second living creature like a calf, the third living creature had a face like a man, and the fourth living creature was like a flying eagle." (Rev. 4:6,7). The same faces were recorded in the vision of the prophet Ezekiel " Also from within it came the likeness of four living creatures. And this was their appearance: they had the likeness of a man. Each one had four faces, and each one had four wings…….each had the face of a man; each of the four had the face of an ox on the left side, and each of the four had the four had the face of an eagle." (Ezek.1:5-10).
