



The more I read God's word,


The more I will be able to understand and enjoy it.

The name Luke means Light





By nationality St. Luke was a Gentile from Antioch

St. Luke's Gospel was written around the year Late 50's – 60's AD

St. Luke's Gospel – Audience & Purpose

St. Luke's addresses his gospel to Theophilus . So it is the only Gospel that is addressed to an individual .



St. Luke's Gospel is symbolised by An Ox/Calf while the other 3 Gospels are symbolised by the Face of a Man, Lion and the Eagle .



St. Luke's Gospel is represented by an Ox/Calf because...


The gospel starts with the story of Zacharaeus

(the priest who offered a sacrifice on the altar according to the Old Testament rituals, which was a symbol of our true sacrifice (Jesus Christ who offered His life for us on the cross))



St. Luke's Gospel – Key Themes

St. Luke focuses his attention on ..



- The complete humanity of Jesus.
 - ❖ Jesus is a friend of all the humans, and specially the sinners, the needy, and the lost and He is joyfully waiting for their repentance
 - ❖ Jesus is also the **PERFECT MAN** who came to save the human race from all its misery.
- He is the Son of Adam as well as the Son of God.



St. Luke's Gospel – Unique Characteristics



St. Luke's Gospel is known as the Gospel of Joy because it has a lot of Praises in it .

Praises in St. Luke's Gospel

Ch1:42-45, Ch1:46-55, Ch1:68-79, Ch2:29-32, Ch2:38

Miracles in St. Luke's Gospel ...(20 and 6 of them unique to this gospel).

- The catch of fish (5:1-11).
- The widow's son (7:11-18).
- The woman with 18 years spirit of infirmity (13:10-17).
- The man who had dropsy (14:1-6).
- The ten lepers (17: 11-19).
- Malchus' ear (22:50-51).



St. Luke's Gospel – Unique Characteristics

Parables in St. Luke's Gospel.. (22 and 17 of them unique to this gospel)

- The good Samaritan (10:25-37).
- The rich fool and his barns (12:16-21)
- The barren fig tree (13:6-9).
- The lost coin (15:18-10).
- The prodigal son (15:11-32)
- The unprofitable servants (17:7-10).
- The widow and the judge (18:1-8).
- The Pharisee and the publican (18:9-14).
- The servants and the pounds (19: 11-27).
