David's Life –David's sin and Repentance Code: 9/OT/12 (2 Sam.11-13; 15-19)

1. General Aims of the unit.

Better Understanding of the history of the People of God in the promised land (the 12 historical books) and how God was dealing with them when they inherited the promised land

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. To review the circumstances when David thought about doing his sin.
- 2. To highlight the mistakes that David did that led him to sin
- 3. To uncover the devilish plan of David for cover up his sin.
- 4. Explore the meeting of the Prophet Nathan and David and its results. Highlight the value of David confession why the sin of David cause the enemies of the Lord to blaspheme.
- 5. Explore the results of the repentance of David and point to some of the Psalms of repentance (Ps. 6, 51)
- 6. To highlight the reward of sin in the life of David (sin of Amnon against his sister Tamar, Absalom killed his brother Amnon, revolt of Absalom against his father David trying to kick him out of the kingdom and replacing him)

3.Outcomes

By the end of this lesson the teens are able to:

- 1. Prove that the reward of sin is death from the life of David and his famous fall.
- 2. Debate :why David fall in the worst two sins 'adultery and killing'
- 3. Discuss the value of David's sin to the whole church.
- 3. Remember by heart the steps of David repentance.
- 4. Appreciate the tears in repentance (Ps.6)
