The book of Ruth-The reward of faithfulness Code: 9/OT/6

1. General Aims of the unit

Better Understanding of the history of the People of God in the promised land (the 12 historical books) and how God was dealing with them when they inherited the promised land

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. To review briefly the history of the people of God during the time of judges as an introduction to the book of Ruth.
- 2. To give a brief of the book of Ruth , the most probable writer and the time of writing . The events recorded in this book. Concentrate on the qualities of Ruth (the Moabites) and her faithfulness to her mother in law and to the God of Israel.
- 3. Explore the reward Ruth received from the God of Israel
- 4. Explain the habit of the "right of redemption" in Israel and its aim.

3.Outcomes

By the end of this lesson the teens are able to:

- 1. Differentiate between Ruth and Orpah .
- 2. Analyze the decision of Ruth to leave her land and go to a foreign land with her mother in law, her sacrifices and rewords in that decision.
- 3. Show the similarities between Boaz and Jesus Christ & Ruth and the church of the Gentiles
- 4. Debate the virtue of Ruth and how they can get this virtue.
