Why the Spirit departed king Saul - "Disobedience" Code: 9/OT/9 (1 Sam.9- 15)

1. General Aims of the unit

Better Understanding of the history of the People of God in the promised land (the 12 historical books) and how God dealing with them when they inherited the promised land

2. Special aims of the lesson

- 1. To review the life of king Saul as mentioned in the book of 1st. Sam. 9-15.
- 2. To highlight the good points in king Saul
